Roll Racing

- Wait for the starter to wave you forward
- The Tower lane is the lead, max 60km/h
- The Crowd lane is to keep pace
- If cars are even, there will be a green light at the 330' mark
- A crew member on the finish line will radio through the winner

Confirm your bracket.
Rnd 1 Qualifying.

Saturday May 17th

Rnd 2 and 3 Qualifying
Nominate your Dial In
in the staging lanes.
Rnd 1 Elimination

Sunday May 18th

Rnd 2 and 3 Elimination
Win 3 Elimination rounds,
the 2 closest to their Dial In will
go through to the finals

Springmount Street

Contested by vehicles with an ET of 13.00 or slower.

Real Street

A/RST: Built after 2013 with an ET between 9.00 and 13.99 / 165mph

B/RST: Built between 2003 and 2012 with an ET between 9.50 and 13.99 / 150mph

Must have logbook, licence, DOT tyres, be street registered, no trans brake, no delay box, includes BA, VX and VY

Street Eliminator

Contested by modified vehicles with an ET between 10.00 and 12.99

Competition

Contested by Sedans, Hot Rods, Dragsters, Roadsters and Alteredds
with an ET between 6.50 and 9.99

IHRA Licence and Tech Inspection required

Street Bike

Contested by motorcycles with an ET of 9.50 or slower

Comp Bike

Contested by motorcycles with an ET between 7.00 and 9.50

IHRA Licence and Tech Inspection required

All Racers, Cars and Bikes must comply with
IHRA and Springmount Raceway Safety and
Licensing Requirements.
IHRA Regs can be found at www.ihra.com.au.
A minimum of four (4) competitors will be
required to run a bracket (except Junior
Dragsters), otherwise the bracket will be
combined with another bracket at the discretion
of the Race Director.
